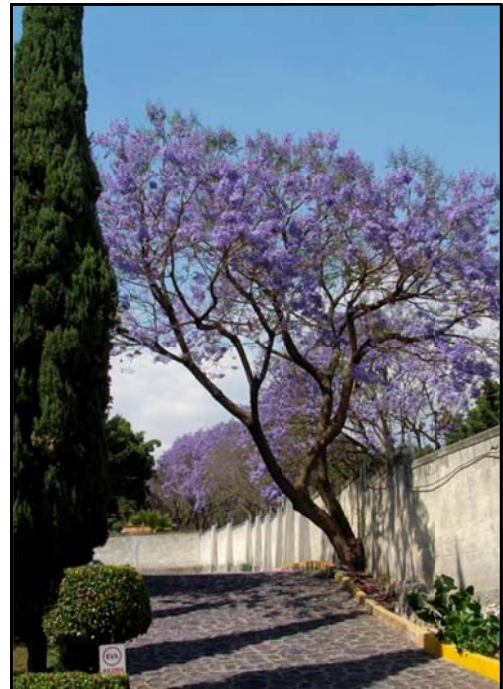

It has a rich colonial history and is the location of many language schools. The easy access, inviting climate, and tourist infrastructure make it an ideal location for mission and construction teams who will serve the orphanage.
